RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. RANGE HOURS: The range is available for use from 9am EST until sunset, 7 days a week, 365 days a year. (Sunset **IS NOT** dark). There are no exceptions to these shooting hours. You may arrive 15 minutes early to set up your equipment, but no shots may be fired before 9am EST.
2. Each member must swipe in and out at the gate for every visit to the range regardless if the gate is already open for a match.
3. Your membership badge must be displayed at all times unless competing in a match.
4. EAGC Guest Policy: Members may bring a guest **FREE FOR THE FIRST VISIT**; and you may bring the same guest for a **second and third visit for a fee of \$10 each day**. Guests must read & sign a club liability waiver (provided at the gate) prior to using EAGC ranges. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR YOUR GUESTS AND THEIR ACTIONS!** Any subsequent visit by the same guest requires that guest to become a paid member. Only three (3) guests may accompany a member for each visit. Members are responsible for the behavior of their guests and they must remain with the member at all times while on the range. Family members are also included in your EAGC membership as associate members. These are defined as a spouse and children under age 19. **You must accompany your associate members and guests on the range, at all times.**
5. Eye and Ear Protection are **MANDATORY** on all EAGC ranges, not only if you are actively shooting, but if any shots are being fired by anyone on the range, eye protection must be worn. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
6. EAGC is a cold range. No loaded weapons may be handled except on a firing line. All guns should be holstered, flagged, or bagged when not on a firing line. After loading, the firearm must be pointed downrange toward the backstop at all times. Do not break the 180 degree plane respective to the rear berm at any time with a loaded weapon.
7. No un-aimed fire. All shots must be controlled and aimed. No bump firing from the hip. Full auto may only be fired in the pistol pits and 50 BMG may only be fired with prior approval. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
8. Rifles, shotguns, and pistols may be fired in all of the pistol pits **EXCEPT FOR** the steel plate pits. Absolutely no rifles of **ANY** caliber allowed on the steel plate racks in the pistol pits. No aerial shots from shotguns allowed on any range.
9. No steel targets may be shot from a distance closer than 10 yards with a pistol or 50 yards with a rifle. Any steel used at EAGC must be AR400/500 (armor plate). No mild steel and no steel with holes or craters allowed. **Spinning steel targets are not allowed.**
10. Firing at cans, blocks of wood, bottles, concrete, or any other object that creates litter or debris is strictly forbidden except for stationary clay birds.
11. **POSITION ALL TARGETS SO THAT ALL BULLETS SAFELY IMPACT INTO THE BERMS. DO NOT SHOOT INTO THE GROUND ON ANY RANGE.** Targets must be set so as to insure that all bullets impact in such a way that they stay on the property and cause no safety problem. This requires that targets be set so that the top of the target is below the top of the berm which must be immediately behind the target. If shooting kneeling or prone your target height will need to be adjusted accordingly. **DO NOT SHOOT AT THE FLOOR OF THE PIT OR AT ANYTHING ON THE GROUND, AS DANGEROUS RICOCHETS WILL OCCUR.** Being a member of EAGC does not give you permission to discharge firearms haphazardly. If used properly no rounds will exit any range. If a round leaves the range from **YOUR** gun **YOU** are responsible for where that round lands and the injury or damage it may cause. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
12. When you arrive at any of the rifle ranges check to make sure no one is downrange checking targets. Only after you have verified the range is clear downrange may you unpack your firearms and set up your bench. When going downrange use the range condition, color, indicator to indicate cease fire or live fire in progress.
13. Absolutely no pistols allowed on the rifle ranges. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
14. RIFLE RANGE CEASE FIRE RULE: All members must work together to go downrange to check or change targets at the same time. Please talk to each other and try to reach a viable accommodation. The rule however is as follows: **The cease fire rule is in effect every time someone wants to go down range.**
15. Only practice tips may be used on the archery range. Absolutely no broadheads or razor tips allowed.
16. No alcoholic beverages shall be permitted on the range, nor shall any person, member, or guest under the influence of alcohol be permitted to remain upon the range. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
17. No incendiary ammunition, tracer rounds, exploding targets, or fireworks are allowed on any range. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
18. No hunting is permitted on EAGC property. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
19. Children must be kept under supervision at all times and are never permitted to play on any of the ranges, whether they are in use or not.
20. Each shooter must police his or her firing area and deposit all used targets, trash, and backers in the proper receptacles before leaving the range. Trash includes spent cases and hulls. Rimfire cases are the exception.
21. Vision barriers/walls, barrels, tables, barricades, sand bags, etc. are EAGC range props. Do not intentionally shoot at range props or range furniture. Violation is considered vandalism and will be treated as such. Target stands take hits but do not aim at them. All club equipment must be properly stored after use. **Failure to observe this rule will result in revocation of your membership.**
