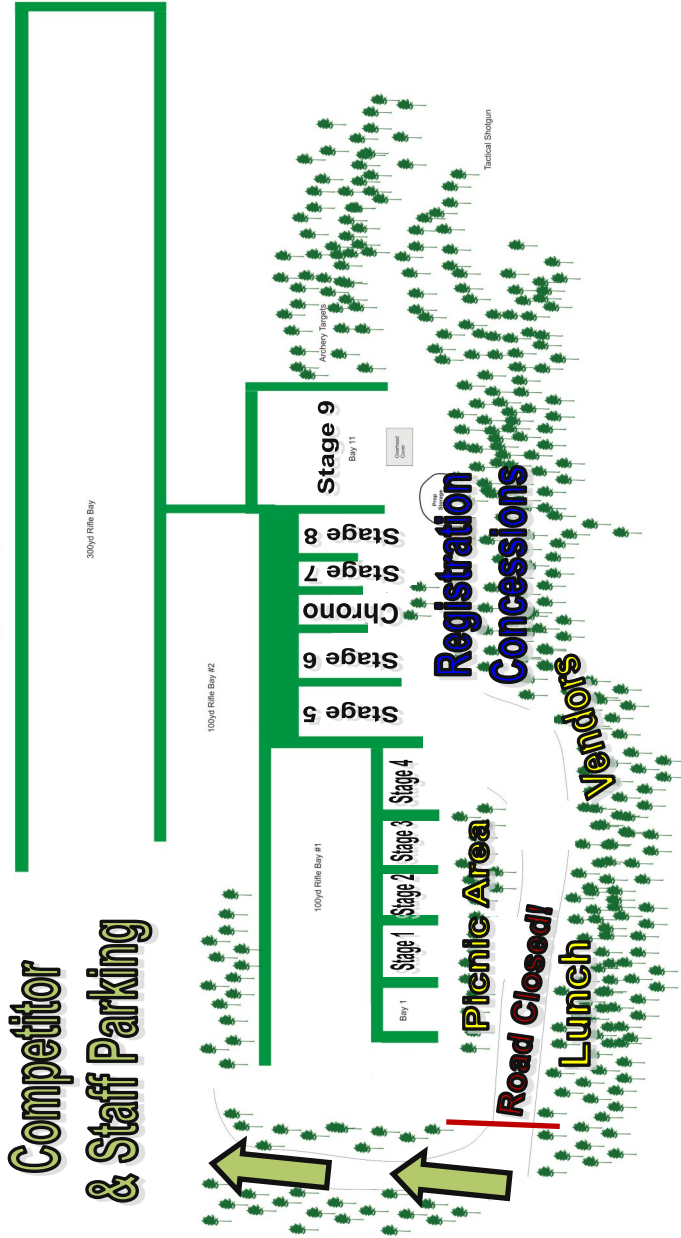

general match rules

THESE POLICIES ARE JUST AS IMPORTANT AS THE RULES. SHOOTERS ARE EXPECTED TO READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL THE CONTENTS OF THIS MATCH PUBLICATION. QUESTIONS WILL BE ANSWERED AT THE SHOOTERS' MEETING.

COMPETITOR AGREEMENT: By competing in this event, you attest that you have read, you understand and you agree to comply with the match rules and regulations.

COLD RANGE: This match is being held on a Cold Range. Firearms will not be handled anywhere on the range except in designated safety areas or under the direct supervision of a certified staff Range Officer. Handling firearms in parking areas is deemed unsafe gun handling.

SAFETY AREA: Safety areas are located around the range to un-bag and holster or un-holster and bag guns, and also for dry fire practice and gun repair, etc. No ammunition may be handled in any safe area.

RULES: The match rules are found in the USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook, Current Edition.

DRAWINGS & DIMENSION: Drawings and dimensions shown in this booklet are approximate and may change due to safety or production considerations. There may be additional no-shoots, vision barriers, or other changes. Inspect each stage carefully and listen to the squad briefing.

OBEY YOUR R.O.'S: Range Officers are here to assist you in completing a safe shooting contest. If there are indications that you are becoming unsafe, attempts will be made to warn you. If your gun handling has become unsafe, you will be stopped. When you hear **STOP!**, or a similar command, **STOP** with the gun muzzle pointing safely down range, finger outside the trigger guard, safety on, and await further instructions.

SET STEEL & PASTE TARGETS: Competitors are expected to stay together as a squad, and if requested, to paste, set steel, and help maintain efficiency on each stage.

HAZARD AREAS: Watch where you walk. For safety, some areas may be roped off.

ALCOHOL: Alcohol may not be consumed anywhere on the range. Competitors violating this policy will be disqualified and asked to leave the range.

EYE & EAR PROTECTION: All competitors must wear eye and ear protection while on the line. Eye protection is required to be worn by *everyone* while on the range.

SPECTATORS: Everyone must wear eye protection while on the range and ear protection is strongly suggested. Climbing on berms is not allowed. Children must be under the *direct supervision* of a parent.

DRESS CODE: Practical shooting is a sport. No camouflage outfits (excluding active duty military), controversial slogans or other items of dubious taste are to be displayed or worn. The Match Director will be the final arbiter of dubious taste. Continued...

LOST BRASS: This is a lost brass match. As a matter of efficiency, all brass collected from the East Alabama Gun Club range is deposited in the designated range pails at the conclusion of the match. Brass is distributed to the range officers at the conclusion of the match in consideration of their hard work.

IMPENETRABLE: All targets, no-shoots, vision barriers, and hard cover zones are impenetrable to a full bullet diameter. Bullets holes that are partially or fully in the non-scoring border will score according to the circumstance. "Unless specifically described as 'soft cover' in the written stage briefing, all props, walls, barriers, vision screens and other obstacles are deemed to be impenetrable 'hard cover'." (9.1.6).

HANDICAPPED SHOOTERS: Competitors may request a penalty in lieu of the stated course requirements by reason of incapacity from previous injury. This must be requested prior to shooting the stage. The Range Master or the CRO only will accept any such requests and the RM will make the decision as to what penalty will apply.

BE ON TIME: Report to the stages on time, and be ready to shoot. Assist with pasting and resetting targets as necessary. Stay at the stage until all members of your squad have shot. It is OK for your squad to move ahead of schedule, but do not skip ahead of another squad.

CHRONOGRAPH: Chronograph stage will be conducted in accordance with USPSA Handgun Rules, June 2010 Edition, Appendix C-2.

VISION BARRIERS: Vision barriers, walls, and props in this match are considered to go from the

Awards/Trophies:

Trophies will be awarded to Division Winner and Alabama Sectional Champion in each division, and in all divisional classifications with over 4 participants. Category Awards (Junior, Lady, etc.) will be awarded in each Division with at least 3 qualifying shooters. Trophy and Cash Prizes will be awarded based on 4/8/12/16 participants. Only first place will be awarded in Unclassified classification. These placing and payouts are based on the number of shooters entered by 1 March. We have to have a cut-off date for trophies to be made, checks to be cut, etc. Prizes donated by sponsors are distributed to competitors via blind drawing prior to the match, and presented in the shooter's welcome bag. 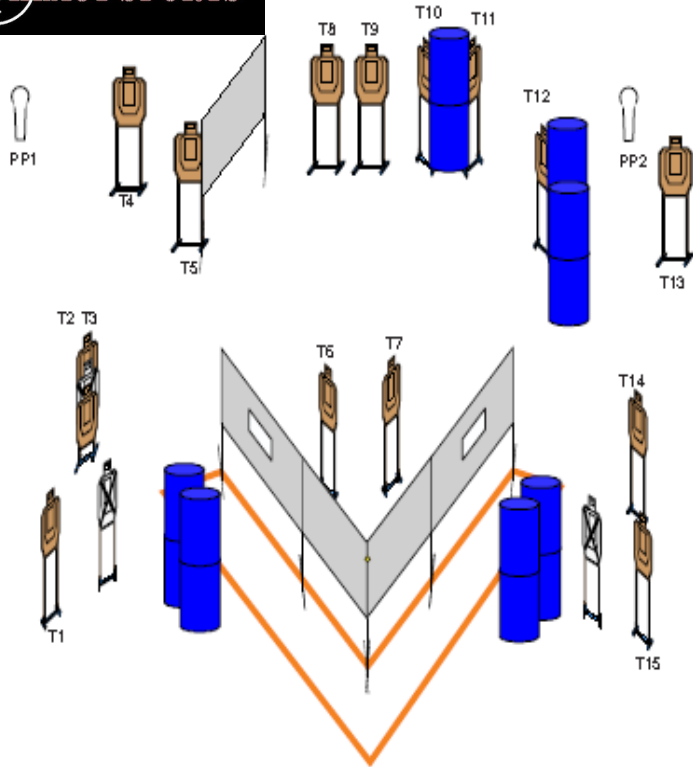

Procedure:	On signal engage targets as you are able from within the shooting area. (Please Note T-6 & T-7 Require 3 Shots).
Scoring:	Comstock, 34 rounds, 170 points
Targets:	15 Metric, 2 Mini-Pepper Poppers
Scored Hits:	Best 2/paper, except T-6 & T-7 which are best 3/paper, Steel must Fall
Start - Stop:	Audible - Last Shot
Penalties:	Per current edition of USPSA Practical Shooting Handbook.
